Rules for Clay Shoots

In the course of **SAFETY** and **GOOD HUNTING** the following **RULES** are to be **STRICTLY ADHEARED TO.**

ALL SHOOTERS MUST REGISTER ON THE DAY

ALL SHOOTERS must have a current Firearm's License Point firearm in safe direction Treat firearm as loaded No Alcohol

PLAY IT SAFE

Accident & Emergency Response Procedure

THINK FIRST!

- 1) Secure your own safety first. Halt the rest of the party.
- 2) Move the causality **ONLY** if in immediate danger.
- 3) Administer first aid , Airway, Breathing, Circulation. Control and treat associated problems i.e. severe bleeding.
- 4) Assess severity of injury and plan evacuation
- 5) EMERGENCY PHONE 111, Ask for ambulance or arrange for helicopter to land nearby, if life threatening.
- 6) While awaiting evacuation, provide comfort and care.
- 7) Record condition regularly;
 - ✓ Pulse rate
 - ✓ Breathing
 - ✓ Treat for shock
- 8) Consider rest of the party. Are the others injured or in shock.
- 9) Emergency assembly area: Safest Place
- 10) Note history of accident and record findings etc. in the note book in the First Aid Kit.
